- **1.** United Way Board Chair, Bob Shearman, called the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m. via zoom with a quorum present.
- 2. The minutes of the August 21, 2020 Board of Directors Meeting were approved as presented.
- 3. Living United Board Member and Campaign Co-Chair Karen Ryan presented the Living United Award to Camillo Vega-Martinez and Sean Waldron of Waterman Broadcasting ABC7/NBC2 for their work on the United Way 2020-2021 PSA and their other work to come on agency videos and the United Way Kick Off.

- 5. Fund Distribution Chair (formerly called Allocations), Tom Uhler, presented the reccomendation from the Team Leaders for the 2021 funding. Team leaders recognized that funding for the United Way partner agenices is more imporatant than ever before. The reccomendation was for level funding with the same \$10.7 Million Goal. That was changed to \$10.8 million and was unanimously approved.
