# WHAT DOES YOUR WEEKLY GIFT PROVIDE?

\$1 a week provides 10 children with back to school clothing, shoes, supplies, and hygiene products through our United Way School Resource Center.



\$5 a week provides over 15 hours of on-site job support and coaching for an individual with disabilities through Goodwill of Southwest Florida.

\$10 a week provides child assessments and counseling sessions for a child fleeing from violence and abuse through ACT (Abuse Counseling and Treatment, Inc).



\$20 a week provides emergency clothing for 5 children after being removed from their homes due to neglect or abuse via the Guardian ad Litem Foundation.

\$25 a week provides a variety of supplies for Saturday Art Projects designed for children and teens on the Autism Spectrum to explore their creative sides while meeting their sensory needs at Family Initiative.



\$50 a week provides weekly community outings for 5 individuals receiving community based training and experiences through LARC, Inc.
